BACKGROUND

UNI DISASTER MANAGEMENT & RURAL DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY is a volunteer organization which is registered under Society Registration Act. XXI of 1860 Govt. of NCT No. S-44011. It was established on 07th Oct' 2002 by a Ex. Army Officers who were working in the fields of basic health, education, environmental protection, rural development, women empowerment and human rights. Organization began with very limited resources as well as manpower. The organization aims to empowerment of the economically weaker & socially marginalized section of the society through capacity building of the people.

UDMRD Society works among rural women, children, handicapped people and poor villagers and urban deprived population. Major areas of interest of the organization are Women Empowerment, Adult Education, Primary & Non – Formal Education, Basic Health, HIV/AIDS Awareness, Environmental Protection, Self Help Groups (SHGs), Employment Oriented Vocational Training, Youth Development, Promotion of Sports, Arts and Culture, Reproductive Child Health and Awareness on various Social, Health and Current issues.

UDMRD Society is a Non–Government Organization for the development of oppressed and vulnerable sections of the society in All India. The organization has been initiated by a group of individuals committed for the development of rural and urban communities of All India in 2001 under the guidance of Mr. Vijay Crowther who has got a three decades of long experience in the field of development.

The Society has started its interventions in the areas of Education, Health, Child Labor, Women Empowerment, Urban Environmental Pollution Control, CRECHE, Consumer Welfare Programme, Women and Child Health Care, Computer Training etc.

1. WELFARE PROGRAMME

As a part of the Health welfare Programme, the Society organized two days workshop cum awareness Programme at district level & All India. More than 60 youths including girls representing from different clubs, schools, local women and students participated in the 2 (two) days Doctors and volunteers delivered lectures on different health aspect of the country.

2. WOMEN'S AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The programme envisages one year's consistent efforts and one to one contact with the women living in North Cachar Hills Dist. Through various platforms created for the purpose of the women Self – Help – Groups and Mahila Panchayats. The programme envisages for support and Counseling so that they are given moral and educational support in times of distress and to fight against their exploitation.

3. WORKSHOP ON ANIMAL WELFARE PROGRAMME

Two days workshop on animal welfare cum training programme was conducted by UDMRD Society at North Cachar Hills Dist. About 150 participants comprising of village volunteers, youths, students and farmers participated the camp, Resource persons from the department of veterinary and Animal Husbandry, local leaders delivered lectures on various schemes for the welfare of the Animal and particularly animal distress circumstances and emphasized the needs for proper care and attention while undertaking the Programme.

4. ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMME

UDMRD Society works for Adult Education. Illiteracy is a major obstacle towards self – reliance. UDMRD Society as developed literacy programs as well as technical education programme for people from 15 to 35. there are 1500 people enrolled across the districts. Organization provides them counseling & carrier guidance especially to those who did not develop technical skills through a formal education program, and to youths who discontinued their education. Programs as Training on Tailoring & Embroidery, Computer Trainin Health Education etc.

□ TRAINING ON TAILORING & EMBROIDERY :

The Society has conducted an Embroidery cum tailoring since 2006 – 2007 with own sources of fund for the welfare and skill up gradation of the rural women of the surrounding areas under the Programme, 40 numbers of poor B.P.L. beneficiaries have been providing training at SantNagar North Delhi

□ COMPUTER TRAINING :

The Association has been conducting computer training course with own fund of the society and providing training on computers education and information technology to the 25 number of students by the trained and expert staff of the organization.

5. SEMINAR OF TRADITIONAL ART & CULTURE

The Society organized one das workshop Programme on the traditional Art and Culture on the 15th April 2006 in Tousem of Manipur, more than 150 participants representing from youth clubs Associations Under the Guidance of Mrs Ibohm, Mahila Mandals organized the Programme, Demonstration cum cultural show form and style of traditional Manipur Local song were protested by the expert artists, school children also took part in the Programme and presented.

6. CAMPS, SEMINARS CONDUCTED

UDMRD Society has launched Medical camps for polio for primary health care of infants in the Mukundpur Village, North Dist. Delhi Invited Doctors specialized in various faculties to attend the said camp and also 300 peoples were examined for communicable diseases.

7. PEACE CAMPAIGN

The Society has conducted a peace campaign at Village Mukundpur & Santnagar Burari, North Dist. Delhi . In the said campaign the necessity of communal Harmony was stressed. The unity among the diversity was taught to the participants, the persons pertaining to various castes of the religious heads were also invited and they expressed their happiness and ambition in continuing of this type of programmes in future.

8. INTERNATIONAL WOMAN'S DAY PROGRAMME:

With the help of Govt. of India, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, we observed International Women's day on 08th March at Village Mukundpur, North Dist. Delhi Community Hall. A large number of woman from different village participated in the Programme and F.P.O., Mrs. Sarla Samuel has given her precious speech on women's distress.

9. LEGAL AND LAW AWARENESS FOR WOMEN

A Programme of two days was organized for the legal rights awareness of women and also the knowledge of law relating to Hindu marriage act was also made aware to them .
