24-25April 2008

A legal aware ness camp was organized with the help of partner NGO in Mizoram in that event 120 ladies from all places of state participated The function was also got the recognition0 from the state government.

8th May 2008

A seminar was organized at United Services Institution, Rao Tula Ram Marg, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi. The Scientist Ms. Catriona Child was among the Scientist spoke about the environmental changes in India and showed the great concern of shifting and cracking of land in U.P around Kanpur, Hamirpur and other areas. Although the Indian Scientists happen to mention that it is due to shortage of water. Hence the crack over earth surface are visible.

10th July 2008

14th November 2008

A Health programme was carried out at the Burari Truck Union stand in which the T. B/HIV pamphlets were distributed and an awareness programme was made success.

05 December, 2009

Pushp Project, which is running with the support of DAP Australian High Commission participated in OZ HAAT MELA. The products made by the trainees, were shown to the High Commissioner which was appreciated by the High Commissioner.
