22nd and 24th October, 2009

community leaders and the participants and thus achieved the aim objective of NCW regarding making the women awareness of Legal affairs.

05 December, 2009

Pushp Project, which is running with the support of DAP Australian High Commission participated in OZ HAAT MELA. The products made by the trainees, were shown to the High Commissioner which was appreciated by the High Commissioner. The girls, who had been getting training at the Project Centre, also met other dignitaries. The event was a moral boosting factor for the NGO and the trainees.

1st January, 2010

The trainees, who had benefited from the Beautician Course basic training have requested for organizing Advance Course for Beautician Training. The girls are desirous of getting in-depth knowledge so as to be able to get better jobs/avenues out side their own homes and improve their economic conditions. The project is in the pipe line at final stages of being started.

2nd January, 2010

NGO Training portal programme was carried out for one week which was given training to two students for Executive level & distributed experience certificates to them. These students were from IIM indore. The training was feather in the cap.

11th January, 2010

Meeting was organized at the IRISH EMBASS for the distribution of certificate for the first batch of graduation of the Beautician Training Center (PRIANKA). Which was attended by ten students and the distribution of certificates was honored by the Deputy Chief of the Mission Mrs. Lavina Collins.

1st February, 2010

The Training center was shifted to new location and got reactivated with effect from 01 Feb2010 and the new Coordinator Mrs. Kusum was installed to look after both the centers PRIYANK and PUSHP at Burari.

With the help of our Associate NGO 'ERD Trust', we organised a Women Awareness Programme on International Women's day on 08th March at Village Mukundpur. A large number
